*We provide each horse with the following:

*A fenced pasture area, paddock, or bedded indoor stall which shall be cleaned a minimum of 6 days a week by P.P.E.C. staff.

*Provide feed twice daily to each horse and maintain adequate water supply to every horse. Although P.P.E.C. purchases high quality alfalfa hay, P.P.E.C. does not warrant the quality of any feed. If veterinarian requested, boarders may provide their own feed at their expense and P.P.E.C. will administer such feed to the boarder's horse as requested (please see restrictions below).

*Provide 24 hour access to the boarding facility as needed for boarder to visit and care for their horse.

Boarder agrees to submit a release form to P.P.E.C. for any guests of the boarder before they are allowed onto the borders horse while on the

deem necessary or desirable. The boarder shall be responsible for any incidental expenses incurred by P.P.E.C. as a result of providing any

diseases, including the vaccinations required at initial move in. It is the boarder's responsibility to exercise and groom the horse unless

Jennifer Serpa-Bootow, dba: Prado Park Equestrian Center - BARN RULES

We have few rules at P.P.E.C., but please adhere to them to make P.P.E.C. enjoyable for everyone.

- Arenas are for riding first. Please limit turn-outs to 10 minutes. Turnouts are NOT allowed in the Dressage court or jumping arena.
- Please do not leave your horse unattended in any arena.
- Please do not tie horses to arenas or corrals. Tie only at tie rails. Boarder will be financially liable for any damage caused by tying to panels or other structures.
- Tack storage is limited to tack shed areas. Community tack storage is 4 horses to one shed. Boarders are not allowed to store personal property not related to horses in their sheds. Boarders are allowed to own and store on the property one shed for tack. One additional shed for feed storage will be allowed if pre-approved by the management. Electric lighting, refrigerators, microwaves, TVs, extension cords, or other electrical devices or connections are not allowed inside tack sheds. Please use 9V or other battery operated or solar lighting.
- Please do not take out or turn out any horse not belonging to you unless you have the owner's permission.
- Feed credit is allowed with a letter from a licensed veterinarian stating your horse cannot safely consume alfalfa hay full-time. Feed credit is applied to either A.M. or P.M. feedings or both. No "split" flakes are allowed. Feed credit may change from month-to-month in value based on the current price of alfalfa hay. Boarders are not allowed to bring alfalfa hay into the ranch. Please use trash receptacles for garbage. If you are disposing of shavings bags and grain sacks, please drop them in the large dumpster at the ranch entrance. Old mats, wood stall boarders and large items must be disposed off on your own accord and off site.
- Please do not take hay from the barn without prior approval from management, or let your horses "free-feed" at the hay barn.
- Upon termination of boarding agreement, any items left on the property after 15 days will become the property of Prado Equestrian Center. Horse trailers left will be billed at \$85.00 per month for storage.
- Excess alcohol consumption, foul language, and gossip will not be tolerated at P.P.E.C..
- In the case of excessive damage to stall/corrals by draft horses, boarder is responsible for part replacements (corrals, feeders etc). P.P.E.C. will install and cover labor costs for all necessary replacements.

The following rules are by the request of San Bernardino Regional Parks Dept. and/or the Army Corp of Engineers.

Wood side boards are only allowed in the stalls if height is less than 18" from the ground.

- Only feed bins for regular feedings are allowed next to your stall. If possible, use only Rubbermaid style or similar containers no deeper than 36". A fire truck must be able to make access down every isle.
- If parking a horse trailer at Prado Equestrian Center. Registration tags must be kept current and tires must remain functional and inflated at all times. Only one trailer at 16' or less is allowed per boarder. Additional trailers brought in and parked will be billed at \$85 per month or prorated at that rate. Trailers over 16' will be billed at \$10 per month per foot over 16" Please lock your trailer. We are not liable for stolen or damaged horse trailers.
- Please do not enter or ride inside the park grounds—trail use only. Park entry for picnicking, dog walking or any other use requires entry from Euclid Ave.
- Any improvements done on the property become the possession of Prado Equestrian Center upon termination of boarding agreement. This applies to corrals, shelters, permanent sheds, and any stationary items left.
- All guests of boarders must sign a release form before being allowed onto any horse, boarded or otherwise while on the premises.
